

# Make Unique Products in 3 Easy Steps!

ARTWORK DUE BY OCTOBER 23

**1** Have your student create their artwork following these guidelines:

## DO

- \* Be sure that students press hard for a rich color if using crayons
- \* Use bright, bold colors that will reproduce best
- \* Fill the entire sheet of paper edge-to-edge, but keep important details at least 1" from the edge of the paper or they may be cut off during production

## DON'T

- \* Use glitter of any kind, including glitter glue, glitter markers or glitter crayons
- \* Use fluorescent, brights and metallics
- \* Include trademarked or copyright images or logos. This includes brand names, emojis, video game/cartoon characters, stickers, magazines/newspaper prints

**2** Return the finished artwork by October 23:

## HYBRID STUDENTS

- \* Return your artwork to your teacher, in the original bag with completed form  
or
- \* Return your artwork to the bin in the foyer through the front doors of the school, in the original bag with completed form

## REMOTE STUDENTS

- \* Return your artwork to the bin in the foyer through the front doors of the school, in the original bag with completed form  
or
- \* If you choose, you can scan your artwork at home and submit it to Original Works (note: submitting your artwork this way will allow you to order products but will not show your child's artwork in the online gallery)

**3** **Order online!** Once the art has been scanned by Original Works, it will be posted to a private online gallery where you can see your child's art on each product. You will receive ordering instructions along with the return of your child's original artwork. Online ordering should be available beginning November 19, and orders take approximately 2 weeks to arrive to your home.
