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How does it work?

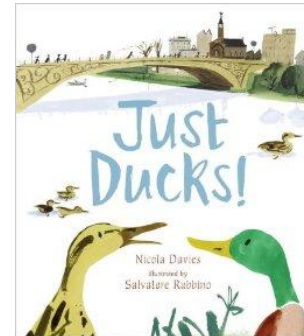
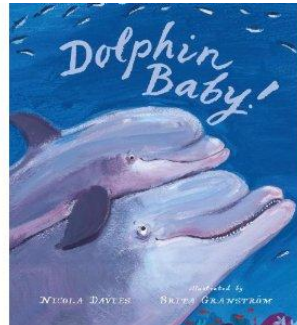
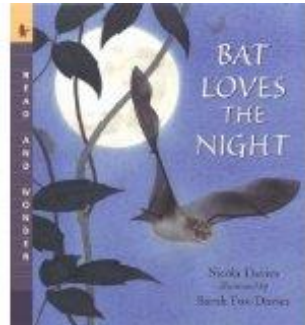
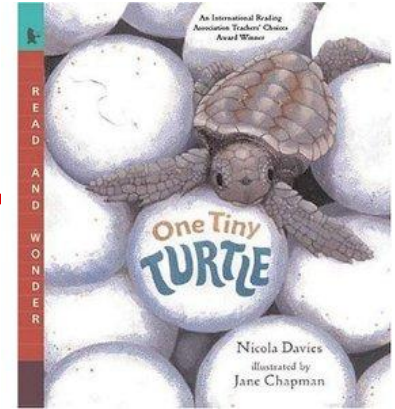
- Establish a general budget (this year ~20K)

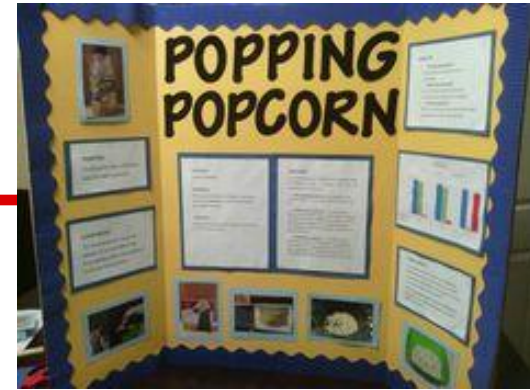
